
2.8 Self-Assessment (WCC projects only)

WCC will enable projects to be "Self-Assessed" by project developers during the lifetime of the project following initial Verification (i.e. after the 5-year verification and once the project is in "Verified" status). The Self-Assessed status and workflow will not apply for Peatland.

When a project developer completes a self-assessment, they are required to submit documentation to demonstrate that the project is on track. The self-assessment will be completed instead of a third-party verification and requires the project developer to complete a Project Progress Report and to provide site-based and aerial imagery. The process for initiating and completing a Self-Assessment will be as follows:

- Step 1: The project developer submits the project using "Submit for Self-Assessment" button. The project status changes to "Pending Review Self Assessment (3rd Party)" and the user will have to submit a Project Progress Report and site-based and aerial imagery before submitting the project for Self-Assessment.
- Step 2: Regulator Reviews the Project
- Step 2a: In case of Approval, the Project status changes to "Pending Review Self Assessment (Markit)"
- Step 2b: In case of Rejection, the Project status changes to "Pending Review Self Assessment (Customer)". User can again submit the project after reviewing the comments received from the regulator
- Step 3: Markit Operations Reviews the Project
- Step 3a: In case of Approval, the Project status changes to "Self-Assessed"
- Step 3b: In case of Rejection, the Project status changes to "Pending Review Self Assessment (3rd Party)". Regulator can again review the project after going through the comments received.




The user will be required to upload the Project progress report and site-based and aerial imagery and then click on the

 The project will then be approved by the Regulator and Markit operations, before being approved. The project will have the status Pending Review (3rd party), Pending Review (Markit) and Self-Assessed at each stage respectively. Once approved by the Regulator and Markit Operations the status of the project becomes "Self Assessed"





Note:

At the next verification, when units are converted, the project status will change automatically from "Self-Assessed" to "Verified" as soon as any unit issuance is converted or approved.
