2. Registry Functions

The UK Land Registry provides account holders a wide variety of functions enabling them to manage their projects and associated credits throughout their lifecycle. This section covers those features in detail.

2.1 Project Registration


Projects for both WCC and PC can be registered as individual projects or as group projects. This section explains the step by step process for how to register the individual as well as grouped project. The user will need to login to the registry and follow the steps below. Note that fields marked with a red asterisk * are mandatory and have to be completed before you can submit a project.

Individual Project


- Navigate to My Projects and Issuance tab
- On the new screen that comes up, select the account name found on the left side.




Click on the New button and choose the option "New Project" from the dropdown menu

 - Project End Date




Upload Documents

- Click on Documents button and upload the following documents:
 - Map of Site (user can add comments in the Comments column)
 - Carbon Calculations (user can add comments in the Comments column)
- Click on Save button in the 'Upload Documents' screen, then on save again in the 'Project Details' screen. Your project is now in a draft status and you can come back to it at a later date if you need to revise or amend details.
- When you are happy with all the details and documents entered, click 'Under Development' and your project is sent for review by the regulator and Markit operations.



Upon submission, the status of the project changes to Pending Review - Under Development (3rd Party)








The project is now being reviewed by the Regulator. Upon review, the Regulator will take either of the following actions:

 Approve – Upon Approval, the status of the project is changed from "Pending Review – Under Development (3rd Party)" to "Pending Review – Under Development (Markit)"




- Reject If rejected, the regulator will mention the reason of rejection in the comments box of the Project Details form, or by separate email if necessary.
 - At this time, the status of the project is changed from "Pending Review Under Development (3rd Party)" to "Pending Review Under Development (Customer)" as shown below.
 - An automated email will be sent to the user informing about the rejection with the comments.
 - The user will need to make the required changes (e.g. upload the revised carbon calculation document by clicking on the Document button, and remove any older versions) and Submit the project again
 - Upon submission, the status of the project changes back to "Pending Review Under Development (3rd Party)".




Once the project is **approved** by the Regulator, it is then routed to Markit for review. Once Markit Approves the project, the status of the project is changed from "Pending Review – Under Development (Markit)" to "Under Development".

The user will receive an automated email notification confirming that the project is registered as Under Development and informing them about the timeline for the completion of validation of the project.
